Introduction

MissionSCJP5.0 is our premier course, which will be your coach to prepare for the SCJP certification exam and help earn the certification early. Course will equip you with the techniques to make a successful jump into the category of certified Java professionals and be present as a safety net to save you from any hard falls.

Target Audience

This course is for Java programmers, who are comfortable with the basics of the Java language.

The course will optimize the hours spent by student. After evaluating an individual's exposure to Java, it will explain a topic in detail or exclude it altogether, as required. This course will not cover lengthy explanations for a topic, already familiar to a Java programmer.

Entry criteria

- You should be comfortable with basic Object Oriented Programming concepts and with writing basic Java classes.
- In terms of formal education, we do not enforce strict criteria, but we recommend this course to those who have completed their high school (12 years equivalent of education in the respective countries).
- You should have fair knowledge of English language, since the medium of instruction is currently in English. We will be launching courses in other languages in future.

SCJP Version

This course is offered for SCJP 5.0 (Java version 5.0).



Course Duration

This course is offered in two options.

Regular track: 3 months tutor support

You are expected to put on approximately 15 hours per week in study.

Fast track: 2 months tutor support

You are expected to put on approximately 22 hours per week in study.

Number of study hours required per week depends on individual learning curves and backgrounds. Based on your progress, our expert tutors will help you to judge your study hours per week.

The course duration is the period for which tutor support is provided. You may contact your course advisor to buy additional tutor support.

Course Objectives

- Determine the level of student's understanding of the topics covered in SCJP exam.
- Build understanding of required/weak topics using reference books/material supplemented by our study notes.
- Familiarize with the nuances of the Java language, which is very important to answer the tricky SCJP questions.
